Arma is... 8 miles north of Pittsburg. From Hwy 69 take 640th Rd (South St) east 1.3 miles; high school is on the left.
Registration and parking are on the north side of building.

Showers will be available at the school all day.

AWARDS CEREMONY: Men 5, Wmn 1/2, 3 & 4 - 11:30 AM
Men 1/2, Men 3, Men 4 - 2:00 PM

All USCF rules apply: CPSC approved helmets required. Wheels in/wheels out. Promoter reserves the right to adjust time & distances, alter or change course, cancel and/or combine categories & prize lists and create black holes as deemed necessary on race day.

JUNIORS: There will be a junior gear rollout per USCF rules. Parent or guardian must sign release form for all minors.

RACE SUPPORT: Each race will have both lead and wheel vehicles. Volunteers will be handing up free Trek bottles at the feed zone.

COURSE: A 23.1K / 14.4 mile circuit w/some rollers and a 500 meter long climb 1.2K before the finish line. 109 meters gained each lap. There are 2 BRAND NEW BUTTER SMOOTH RR crossings at the 10K mark; in case of a train USCF rules apply. Feed zone is on the final climb 1K east of high school on South St. Free water bottles by Trek.

LODGING: tailwindcyclists.com has lodging and meal information plus area visitor information. Cheapskates, homeless cyclists, family members and other undesirables may sleep in the Northeast High School Gym Friday & Saturday night for free. Gym opens at 6:30 PM.
