First rider starts at 9 AM. Start times will be assigned on a first come first served basis within each category for pre-registered riders; day of race registrants will start after ALL pre-registered riders of their distance. One minute start intervals. **If you want to be surrounded by your category you must pre-register!** Lunch available at St. Patrick's Church Hall for a donation.

GPS – N 37 deg 36.0506 min W 95 deg 4.6810 min S/F is on Hwy 146. Burns Street is one block south of Hwy 146.
Walnut is... 100 miles south & 20 miles west of KC or 150 miles east of Wichita or 35 miles northwest of Pittsburg.

START TIMES: Official start times will be posted on tailwindcyclists.com by June 16th at 10 PM, emailed to preregistered racers with legible emails & posted at registration on race day.

All USAC rules apply: CPSC approved helmets required. Promoter reserves the right to adjust time & distances, alter or change course, cancel and/or combine categories & prize lists and create black holes as deemed necessary on race day.

JUNIORS: There will be a junior gear rollout per USAC rules. Parent or guardian must sign release form for all minors.

COURSE: 10K is out & back on Hwy 146. 18K & 33K are an "L" shaped course. The first leg is smooth asphalt, second leg is coarse asphalt (NO GRAVEL). Big ring hills abound.

AWARDS CEREMONY: 10 & 18K @ 11 AM. 33K @ Noon or after last racer finishes. Medals awarded to the top three Kansas riders (w/annual license) in each category. Non-Kansas residents are eligible for cash!
